Dear Nursery Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you all safe and well in these unprecedented times. Thank you for completing the Nursery Google form requesting a place for your child to attend school from **Tuesday 12th January 2021**. **Please read this important information**

Please do not send your child to school if you or anyone in your household had Covid-19 symptoms:

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

If your child does develop symptoms, you can seek advice from the nhs.uk website at <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/check-if-you-have-coronavirus-symptoms/>. If you are concerned about your child's symptoms, or they are worsening you can seek advice from NHS 111 at <https://111.nhs.uk/> or by phoning 111. **Please notify the school if your child becomes symptomatic and consequently tests positive.**

What are the dropping off and collection arrangements?

One only adult per family will be allowed to drop off or collect their child. Social distancing should be maintained and a face covering should be worn by the adult whilst queuing. Please ensure children arrive on time and are collected promptly in accordance with the table below in order to help prevent 'bubbles' mixing and the virus from spreading.

- A box of tissues for the school – thank you
- Individual named hand sanitiser if you wish

How can I contact the school?

In the first instance please email the school at officeemail@ruislipgardensschool.co.uk or leave a voicemail on the school answerphone (the office is currently not fully staffed). You will not have an opportunity to enter into a dialogue with school staff at drop off or collection times as our priority will be the safety of the children, so all queries should come into the office email or you can contact your child's teacher on the class email.

What are the arrangements for lunchtime? Full time pupil's only

Children should bring a packed lunch (please do not send in any items containing nuts as we have children with severe allergies). Please ensure your child has any cutlery required e.g. spoon for yoghurt.


Week commencing 18th January, the school kitchen will offer hot meals. A lunch order form will be sent via ParentPay.
