As you are aware, Ruislip Gardens Primary School was inspected at the beginning of June. The report is now ready for parents and other stakeholders to read before it is posted on the Ofsted website next week.

Since the last inspection in March 2017 and especially since the new leadership team began in September 2019, the school has improved significantly. This would not have been possible without the dedicated staff, the hardworking children and the support we have received from parents/carers. The inspectors recognised the substantial journey the school has been on and that *“as a result, pupils benefit from a good and improving education.”*

In the report, you will see that the school has been judged as ‘good’ in all areas.
