



## Ruislip Gardens Pupil Premium Provision Map 2019 - 2020

The key objectives in using the Pupil Premium Grant at Ruislip Gardens are to narrow the achievement gap between those in receipt of Pupil Premium and others and to provide an enriching and stimulating curriculum to expand pupils' cultural and social development.

We seek to provide a curriculum enriched with opportunities from internal events to external trips to support and extend learning in both the core and foundation subjects.

The current funding is approximately **£101,555.00**. Estimated costs have been allocated in the following way.

### Teacher release time

**Aim:** To release senior members of staff to work with booster groups of pupils to ensure personalised learning.

**Outcomes:** More PP pupils reach national + attainment expectations in reading, writing and maths in Year 2 and Year 6.

**Cost: £14,000**

### Literacy interventions

**Aim:** Support staff to implement one-to-one and small group intervention to support pupils in all years based on specific needs dependent of year group. These include:

**Phonics based interventions:** 3 x a week

**Handwriting:** Small groups in KS1 and LKS2

**Reading:** Small groups in LKS2 and UKS2

**Vocabulary:** Small group sessions

**Reading buddies:** 3 x a week for 20 minutes

**Outcomes:** To accelerate rates of progress in all subjects across all year groups.

**Cost: £20,500**

## Academic

### Numeracy interventions

**Aim:** Pupil Premium Learning Mentor to implement one-to-one and small group intervention to support pupils in all years based on specific needs dependent of year group, whether that pushes forward into greater depth or close the gap to expected.

**Outcomes:** To accelerate rates of progress in all subjects across all year groups.

**Cost: £20,000**

**Total spend on Academics per year:**

**£54,500**

### Well being

#### Lego therapy

**Aim:** Group based sessions used to promote team work, build confidence in small group sessions using Lego building blocks and instructions.

**Outcome:** Pupils' self-confidence grows as they take on roles of responsibilities to achieve a set task. Pupils develop communication skills; develop emotional understanding and how to behave with others in social situations.

**Cost: £2000**

#### ELSA mentor

**Aim:** To provide emotional support to individuals at a more intense level to remove any barriers to attainment.

**Outcome:** Pupils are able to develop social skills and become more focussed in class with positive outcomes for attainment and progress. Their self-confidence and happiness improves.

**Cost: £16.000**

#### School uniform and stationery

**Aim:** To ensure all pupils are wearing uniform and to support parent financially by providing uniform and stationery free of charge.

**Outcome:** All PP pupils wearing the correct school uniform and have stationery at school to use in classrooms.

**Cost: £3555**

#### Pets as therapy

**Aim:** Pupils in KS1 and KS2 have the opportunity to work with a Therapy Dog.

**Outcome:** Therapy Dog visits school, pupils spend time with him, including reading to the dog which has had an impact on the confidence and reading ability of the child.

**Cost: £3000**

#### Improved pupil resilience and self-learning

**Aim:** To ensure pupils develop greater independence, learning-to-learn skills and a Growth mindset to approach challenges before seeking adult support.

**Outcome:** Most PP pupils to exhibit increased independence skills and resilience when approaching challenges in order to make good progress.

**Cost: £4000**

#### Welfare and attendance support

**Aim:** To ensure all pupils are supported with their welfare and medical needs and to ensure they attend school regularly.

**Outcome:** All PP pupils have 96%+ attendance and they are fit and healthy for the school year.

**Cost: £8000**

**Total spend on Well-being per year:**

**£36,555**

### Enrichment/engagement

#### Subsidised School Trips

**Aim:** School trips to be subsidised for children when needed and through discussion with parents.

**Outcome:** Children to have access to all school trips provided, thus enriching these children's life experiences, experiences they can draw upon in their learning.

**Cost: £4000**

#### Forest Schools

**Aim:** Intervention program to provide children with outdoors experience and to develop their love of learning, self-confidence and teamwork skills.

**Outcome:** Children to have increased confidence. They will also develop their skills when working with others,

**Cost: £2500**

#### After School Clubs

**Aim:** To increase the number of pupils attending extra-curricular activities.

*Cost: Varies dependent on the cost charged by the provider*

**Outcome:** All pupil premium children have the opportunity to experience extra-curricular activities to promote healthy active lifestyles.

**Cost: £4000**

**Total spend on Enrichment per year:**
