Full Time Pastoral Support Worker & Service Family Support Worker

Overview: Regular 1:1 session with a specialist adult to support emotional needs, particularly during times of employment.

Outcome: Children feel emotionally supported and their emotional literacy develops. Their self-confidence and happiness improves.

Position to be advertised in the summer term

Cost: £11000

Lego therapy

Overview: Group based sessions used to promote team work, build confidence in small group sessions using Lego building blocks and instructions.

Outcome: Children's self-confidence grows as they take on roles of responsibility to achieve a set task. Children develop communication skills, emotional understanding and how to behave with others in social situations.

Cost: £670

Transition out – My passport & memory book

Overview: Children who are leaving Ruislip Gardens have 1:1 or small group sessions to create a passport to take with them to their new school. Children look at the school they are going to in order to prepare them for the change.

Outcome: Children who are leaving Ruislip Gardens have a memento of their time spent with us and their friends write them messages wishing them well.

Cost: £200

Military club

Overview: A group intervention for children from service families to talk about their experiences and to get to know each other.

Outcome: Children feel emotionally supported by each other and can relax and have fun with children who have similar life experiences to them.

Cost: £1500

Coffee mornings/Afternoons

Overview: Families of service children are invited to regular coffee mornings to meet with key staff and other service families.

Outcome: Families have the opportunities to meet with other families and those new to Ruislip Gardens can obtain information and be supported in accessing local services.

Cost: £150

Celebrations/Promotion

Overview: To celebrate days like Christmas, Armed Forces Day, Remembrance Sunday, to recognise, celebrate and thank military personnel, past and present.

Outcome: To promote the culture and context of service children within the school.

Cost: £1086

Camo Day

Overview: We raise money for SSAFA through Camo Day. This also serves to raise the profile of our military families.
